



Eric Meyhofer

Eric Meyhofer was the co-founder and CEO of Uber's Advanced Technologies Group (ATG), leading the 1,400 person team that is bringing self-driving transportation to the Uber network. During his 6 years at Uber, Eric also carried a VP role reporting Uber's CEO. Eric was responsible for a \$1B Series A investment into ATG and later led the sale of ATG that closed in January of 2021.

Prior to co-founding ATG in 2015, Eric spent 11 years at Carnegie Mellon University's Robotics Institute, as a Special Faculty member with a focus on commercializing robotic technologies. During his time in this role, Eric founded several companies that span various robotics fields, from the 3D mapping of underground mines (Mine Vision Systems, Inc.) to companies that use high power lasers to autonomously de-coat F-16 fighter jets (Titan Robotics, Inc.). However, it is one of his early startups, Carnegie Robotics, LLC., that paved the way to landing Uber in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. He has over 25 years of robotics experience.

Eric lives in Pittsburgh with his wife of 22 years and two children.
